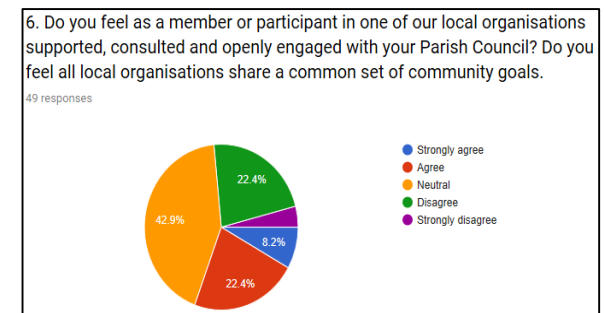
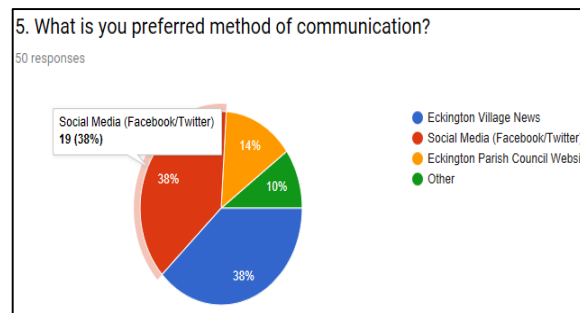
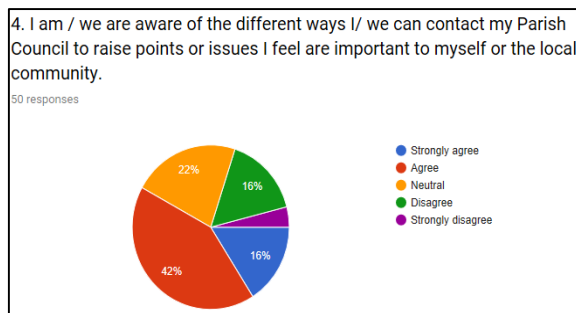
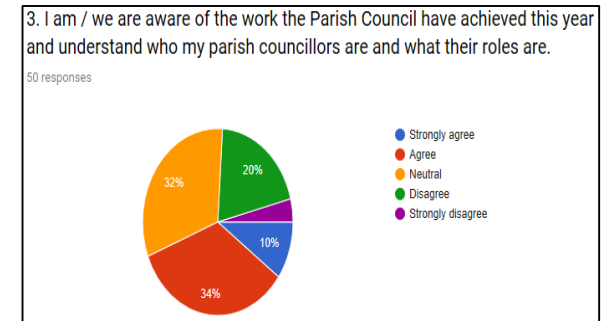
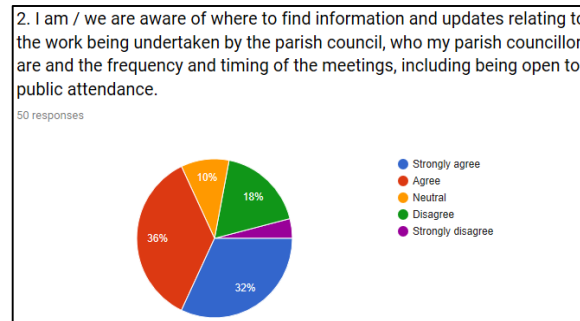
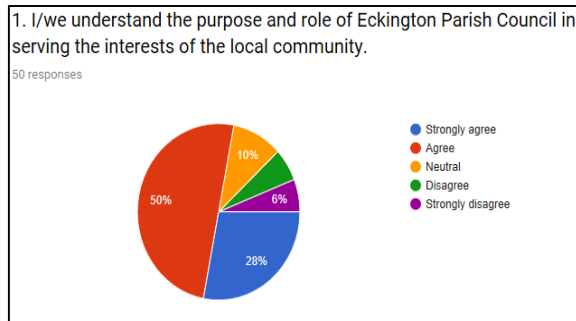


Eckington Parish Council Survey Summary

(February 2019)

- A total of 50 responses have been received



90% responses have been completed by 'individuals'

Themes

- There were a number of responses that detailed some of the work completed by the parish council however other responses suggested that it could be more positively communicated the work had been done.
- Collaborative working between community organisations was considered to be an area where things could be strengthened between different groups and overall responses encouraged closer working.
- Communication; public transport; speeding and parking; roads; parish council membership and accessibility; village security; parish council vision / delivery and dog mess have been received in the survey feedback; much of which is routinely discussed by the parish council.

You said, we will

- 38% said social media was preferred method of communication - new Eckington Parish Council Facebook page has been created and will be regularly updated. Existing communication route will continue.
- Work to improve the availability and accessibility of Parish Councillors within both public meetings and more informally. The PC will consider such options as drop in surgeries, open forums, and updated parish councillor profiles.
- Play a lead role in engaging more closely with local organisations on shared community goals such as annual or more frequent meetings with all local community organisations and through completing shared initiatives.
- Continue to work with the community on addressing the concerns raised in the survey responses, such as speeding within the village through speed deterrent initiatives.
- Further the work with crime prevention partners on initiatives such as Smart water and Neighbourhood watch schemes.
